The Idaho Recreation and Tourism Initiative (IRTI), a coalition of state and federal agencies working with non-profit groups to promote recreation and tourism opportunities, helps fund and promote Be Outside grants each year. Be Outside, Idaho grants, funded by IRTI partners, are awarded to Idaho schools, government entities, and non-profit organizations that encourage youth and their families to get outdoors, including projects that focus on outdoor recreation and natural resource education.

- **Be Outside, Idaho does not fund transportation costs, entrance fees, food costs, school tracks/gyms, permanent personnel salaries, or t-shirts/promotional items.**

While permanent staff cannot be funded through this grant, funding may be allocated for specialized roles that are critical to the project's success. These include interns, Master Naturalists, and other qualified specialists who will contribute to activities such as research, fieldwork, community engagement, and educational initiatives.
